

COOKIES POLICY

Please get acquainted with this Cookies Policy:

The following terms have the following meaning:

1. **"Site"** - means the website available at the following address: <https://perfectcup.pl/>;
2. **"Customer"** - means a natural person acting on his or her own behalf or on behalf of a legal person or organisational unit without a legal personality, but possessing legal capacity under the law, who used the Site by browsing the website available at the following address: <https://perfectcup.pl/> or by sending his or her personal data via the Contact Form available at the Site to obtain specific information about the services offered by the Company;
3. **"User's Equipment" or "Terminal Equipment"** - means the telecommunications equipment belonging to the User, such as, among others, mobile phone, smartphone, computer, tablet or other mobile device with Internet access (telecommunications device intended for direct or indirect connection to the network terminals).

What are Cookies and how are they used?

Cookies are small text files sent and saved by the Site on the User's Terminal Equipment and include data on the User's use of the Site ("**Cookies**"). Cookies are safe for the User's Equipment and they serve facilitating the Site's use.

Information collected by Cookies facilitate the use of the Site, allow remembering the User's preferences and adapt the Site to his or her needs, the files especially allow recognising the User's Terminal Equipment and properly displaying the Site. Cookies are also used to develop statistics concerning Site visits, which allows improving the Site's quality by improving its structure and contents, thus adapting it to the Users' needs.

The Site primarily uses the following types of Cookies:

- a. Persistent cookies - are stored in the User's terminal equipment until they are deleted by the user or for the time specified in the settings.
- b. Session cookies - temporary files that are stored in the User's terminal equipment until logging out, leaving the site or exiting the browser.
- c. User cookies - files used for longer than one session for the purpose of: identifying products or services added to the Site's cart/favourites section, so that the User has access to the products or services added earlier to the cart/favourites after closing the browser and opening it again.

- d. Third-party cookies - especially such files as Google Analytics statistics files and of other third-party entities, allowing to adapt the advertising to the Users' preferences and customs.

Can Cookies be disabled?

You can disable the files if you do not want Cookies on your Terminal Equipment. It is possible that after disabling Cookies, the User will not have access to some of the Site's contents, using the Site can be less effective for the user and it can be harder to use the services.

The User can limit or exclude the use of Cookies by introducing relevant changes in the browser's settings. The User can change these settings especially to block the automatic support of Cookies, or to receive information about each case of saving Cookies on the User's Terminal Equipment. Specific information about the methods of Cookies' support is available in the browser settings.
